





In-prison training: 50 states










In-prison training: 50 states





Diaspora Reaching Cities







# In-Prison Training

# Criteria for Effective Ministry Training

- Contextualized to prison culture
- Accessible to any education level
- Reproducible and skill-based
- For Christian leaders, not new believers
- Long enough to ensure effective transformation



# Capstone Curriculum

The Urban Ministry Institute (TUMI, tumi.org)

- 16 modules/4 years (Bible, Mission, Theology, Ministry)
- Proven effective
- Based on orality in cohort environment
- Broad evangelical spectrum
- \$7500 annual cost has grants available Serving USA



# Capstone Curriculum

- Turn-key admin and video-based curriculum
- Training online with TUMI staff support (10-15 hrs)
- PT volunteer admin, two facilitators (5-10 hrs/week)
- Facilitator profile:
  - 1. ministry/life experience > formal
  - 2. Lead discussion
  - 3. Develop leaders > teacher





2. Why do former prisoners go back after release?


3. How can former prisoners succeed upon release?

#### Re-enculturation

- Prisoners with in-prison ministry training skilled in prison culture
- Prison culture vs. civilian culture
- Need 12-18 months transition
- Church best community to provide
- Onesimus Workshop (4x30-min.)
- Amazon or completion.global/get-involved





## Thesis

Most former prisoners go back to prison, not because they want to commit crimes but because they cannot make the cultural adjustment to civilian life
